Please return your completed application form, an audition recording, and a non-refundable fee of \$100 USD by February 1, 2012 to:

(a 3% processing Credit Card/PayPal charge will apply at checkout).

Requirements:

To be considered for admission to the festival: Every applicant must submit an application, a recording (non-returnable) exhibiting their level of playing, and a non-refundable application fee of \$100 USD (per session). The application will be processed immediately. You are then required to make a \$300 USD deposit due two weeks (14 days) upon acceptance, to reserve a place at the festival. The remaining fees are due by March 20, 2012 (payment in full by March 1, 2012 is eligible for a 10% discount).

Audition Recording Requirements:

- Should be made on the instrument for which you are applying.
- Should contain two contrasting pieces.
- Should be no longer than 30 minutes.
- Recording may be video or audio and sent in any format including email.

Deadlines:

- February 1, 2012:
Application with \$100 non-refundable application fee.
\$160 after February 1, 2012.
- 2 weeks upon acceptance:
A \$300 deposit to reserve a place at the festival.
- March 1, 2012:
Students who pay in full by this date are eligible for a 10% discount.
(This is NOT a postmarked deadline.)
- March 20, 2012:
Remaining fees due.
Payments made after this date must be made online.
- Students who wish to attend more than one session are eligible for 10% off a 2nd session.

Above amounts are included in the tuition except \$60 late fee and any processing fees/surcharges/taxes incurred.

Cancellation Fees:

- Cancellation fees may apply, depending on cancellation date.
- Deposit fee will not be refundable after March 1, 2012.
- Remaining fees will not be refundable after April 10, 2012.

Other Requirements and Specifications:

- In case of a teacher's unavailability, the festival reserves the right to reassign students to a different teacher.
- The festival will not be responsible for individual medical coverage and expenses or for the supervision of students.
- Students must submit proof of health insurance.
- A parent or guardian may wish to accompany students under 18 years of age.
- Students are responsible for making their own travel arrangements.
- Not all students will be assigned to the orchestra.
The festival will be making the assignment decisions.
